Help *Protect Your Adirondacks* and *Keep Invasive Species Out* by learning to control invasive knotweed on your property.

Stem injection using approved herbicide products is an effective and environmentally conscious approach to reduce knotweed infestations, minimize their associated impacts, and facilitate the recovery of desirable species.

Participants in the loaner tool program will receive:

- Free access to a stem injection tool
- Written technical guidance on knotweed identification and management techniques
- Technical advice and support from APIPP staff

Eligibility and Limitations. Participants must sign an assumption of risk and release of liability form (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement"). Non-certified applicators may only apply pesticide to their own property. The tool may not be shared with individuals or groups who have not entered into an Agreement. Pesticide applications may not be performed within 100 feet of wetlands, lakes/ponds, rivers/streams, or other water bodies. Participants are solely responsible for obtaining any necessary approvals and/or permits for the use of the equipment in the application of pesticides on their property. All pesticide application must be conducted in accordance with the product label and all local, state, and/or federal law.
