4. Training/Education Event We will have several presentations (20 min each):

Topic 1 – The Glens Falls Watershed: This 3,800 acre watershed serves to provide potable drinking water for city residents. SWCD staff will discuss sampling that the office does to assist in this effort, along with new projects on the horizon to enhance the watershed’s ecology.

Topic 2 – Crandall Pond Enhancement Project. The District is in a grant partnership with the City of Glens Falls to reduce stormwater impacts to the Crandall Pond, and assist to stabilize the shoreline. District staff will review some history of the pond, local impacts and the improvement project. The Crandall Pond outlet is a headwater stream of Lake Champlain.

Topic 3 – Realtime Sampling and Field Observations. Building on past presentations, District staff will walk the group to Crandall Pond and conduct sampling for water quality parameters, evaluate land cover and impacts, and discuss maintenance of managed ponds.
